2008 TOURNAMENT RULES

DEADLINE FOR ENTRY:

6:00AM NOVEMBER 28TH (First day of tournament)

*Payment must be made by cash or check only.
Sorry, credit cards will not be accepted.

WEIGH-INS:

Weigh-Ins will be held at the Ocean City Fishing Center.

Scales are Open: Friday 10am-12noon, 5pm-7:00pm;
Saturday 9am-11am, 5pm-6:30pm

*The Added Entry Level A Daily money will be divided equally into each of the four weigh-in periods, and the boat to bring in the largest fish during any given period will win that portion of the daily money. If no fish are weighed during any given period, the monies will be added to the next period's prize.

The only eligible species of fish for this tournament is the Rockfish. Each boat may weigh 4 fish total within the 36 hour fishing period (excludes Junior Angler Category Fish). The Captain is responsible for determining which fish are the 4 largest to be weighed. All fish brought to the scales must adhere to state and federal regulations and retention limits. Bringing a fish which does not meet these regulations will also lead to an automatic disqualification of the boat and its' anglers. All fish must be cleaned immediately after they are weighed.

Attempted weight alteration of a fish will automatically disqualify the boat and its' anglers from the tournament. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to inspect any fish brought to the scales.

Winners will be selected based on the weight of the single heaviest fish. Fish weights will be rounded to the nearest tenth of a pound. In the event of identical fish weights, prize monies will be awarded to the fish that was weighed first. Boats can not win more than one placing (i.e. can not win first and also second place). Junior Anglers are eligible to place.

BOUNDARIES:

The South Boundary will be the Verrazano Bridge, the North Boundary will be the Delaware line (both on the bay and ocean sides), and the East boundary is no more than 3 miles off (in accordance with state and federal regulations).

WEATHER:

Each registrant is responsible for determining whether he or she will fish in light of current weather conditions. Fishing by any one boat on any day or partial day constitutes a tournament. The tournament will not be cancelled or rescheduled except for extreme weather conditions as determined by the Official Tournament Committee.

* There will be no refunds on entry fees. All monies will be added to the payout of the 2009 Black Friday 550 Rockfish Tournament.

A boat may be replaced after registration if due to breakdown or loss of seaworthiness, but is subject to Tournament Committee approval.

CAPTAIN'S MEETING:

The official tournament radio channel will be 71. In lieu of a captain's meeting, any questions will be answered via radio between 5:30 am and 6:00 am on Friday, November 28th, the first day of fishing, or by telephone prior to the tournament. Changes and alterations to these rules may be made up until that point, in which case all participants will be notified via radio.

BAIT, TACKLE & FISHING TECHNIQUES:

All IGFA tackle rules apply unless stated otherwise.

Live bait is allowed. Each boat may have no more than six lines in the water at any one time.

Any boats caught transferring fish from one vessel to another will be disqualified from the tournament. All fish must be kept on ice, maintained properly, and fit for human consumption. IGFA rules apply regarding mutilated fish. Official tournament weigh master reserves the right to inspect any fish brought to the scales.

Any tournament sponsor or their employees entering the tournament in compliance with the tournament rules are eligible for any and all prizes.

All tournament participants consent and authorize the Tournament Committee, sponsors and their advertising agencies to use and reproduce names, voices, and/or photographs, whether taken or recorded and circulated the same for any and all purposes of publicity and advertising of all kinds and descriptions in any and all media formats.

The Black Friday 550 Rockfish Tournament and its sponsors are not responsible for the conduct, personal injury, damages or negligence on the part of any participant.

All protests must be made in writing and presented at Tournament Headquarters by close of scales on the day of the alleged infraction. Protests must be accompanied by a \$250 cash deposit which will be refunded if the protest is upheld. Otherwise, the deposit will be forfeited.

JUNIOR ANGLER:

The Junior Angler age cut off will be 14. The Junior Angler with the single heaviest rockfish will win a custom fishing rod crafted by Diamondwrap Sportfishing. A Junior Angler may win 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place prize money as long as their fish is one of the four qualifying fish for their boat (See "Weigh-Ins"). If the boat has already weighed their 4 fish, but the Junior Angler has an additional fish to weigh, they may, but will only qualify for the Junior Angler prize of the custom fishing rod.
